

Exchange learning visit at Butungama primary school strengthens child rights promotion and protection advocacy work.

Under the child rights promotion and protection program, RIDE AFRICA with support from WeSeeHope facilitated an exchange learning visit for 4 primary schools of Masojo, Kasungu, Kabimbiri and Kyabukunguru on 9th August 2024 hosted at Butungama primary school. The exchange learning visit attracted 16 participants who included head teachers, club patrons, child rights desk officers and human rights ambassadors. The learning visit strengthened the capacity of the head teachers, club patrons, child rights desk officers and HRAs in child rights promotion and protection advocacy work through poems, songs, reviewing records kept by the host school/club among others.
